SIMPLICITY IN FURNITURE.

It has now become a necessity on the part of those intending to Furnish a House to take some little thought about the special requirements of each room. The day is past, let us hope, when meagreness or redundency of ornament was the only known sign by which one class of furniture was distinguishable from another—suitability of purpose, refinement of colour, and proportion and quality of workmanship being matters supposed to be beyond the ken of ordinary individuals. The present decade, however, has witnessed a growing interest in Decorative Art and the exhibitions of the "Arts and Crafts" and kindred societies, as well as the prominent place given in the Art Magazines, to the consideration of the artistic crafts, have done much to create an interest in these things in the public mind. Keeping these considerations in view, the designs in this book have been prepared to meet the requirements of those, who regard the part or total furnishing of a house as a subject deserving serious consideration, and who question the advantage (held out by many firms) of furnishing completely for £150 to £1000.

The Designs included in this book are not intended to be taken as representing the "Stock;" they only indicate the kind of work executed, and shew the relative prices of different pieces of furniture. It will be readily understood that the special needs of people and rooms vary considerably. A Dining-Room, for instance, may be either over or under furnished by the regulation Dining-Room Suite (six hand and two easy chairs, a couch, a handsome sideboard, and extending table, &c.) These are often crowded into a room capable of containing comfortably half the number of pieces indicated. A room should be furnished to give the maximum comfort, and not in such a manner as to suggest that the living occupants are intruders. The Sideboards numbered 7, 24, and 25 have been designed to suit a room too small to contain the usual Dining-Room Suite

The features which have been considered in the production of the furniture illustrated are, first —

UTILITY.—In the Overmantel numbered 151, the arrangement of cupboards and shelves is the result of recognising the possibilities of the case. In a room one is using constantly for at least nine months of the year, one's interest gathers round the fireside. It is here the master of the house expects to find the "necessary" luxuries of life, his favourite authors, his pipe and pouch, and the monthly magazines. For all these and other silent friends who provide companionship for many quiet hours, he will find the necessary accommodation in such an Overmantel. Attention might also be drawn to the two Ottoman Seats, numbered 95 and 92.

WORKMANSHIP.—The furniture is made entirely by hand: that means, among other things, that all dovetail and other joints are sawn, not "knocked out" by machinery. Each piece of furniture is constructed of the best-seasoned wood only, and, after being accurately fitted, is taken to pieces to be toned and polished. The toning may be practically of any colour, but preferably of Brown, Green, or Black. Another method is treating the wood with oil colour, the finished result bringing out the fine grain of the wood. The furniture is carefully packed for delivery only after it is thoroughly dry. As each piece is made specially on receipt of order, Patrons have an opportunity of indicating Colour of Toning and scheme of colour for panels. The construction of the larger pieces occupies about twenty-one days.

GOOD DESIGN.—This feature has been mentioned last, as it is the natural result of sound construction and utility. Any piece of furniture which is simply and soundly made suggests the use for which it is intended; it proclaims itself as the direct outcome of a felt want. It will be noticed that the furniture illustrated has little or no ornamentation. In this respect it is a protest against the plethora of over-decorated machine-made furniture which forms such a large portion of the intending purchaser's choice. There ought to be a suggestion of "preciousness" in the enrichment of useful furnishings, and this is lost when the decoration is applied lavishly and without discrimination. When a piece of furniture is so much covered by carving that its original form is lost, one naturally thinks of carving turned out by the yard, as it often in reality is. From the furniture herein illustrated the numerous knobs and excrescences so often seen are entirely absent. The turning lathe is responsible for much of this spurious "decoration."

The Schemes of Colour for Panels have not been indicated, these depending very largely on the general tone of each piece, and on the predilection of the patron for certain schemes. The intention, however, is to keep the general tones sombre, with small points of interest in stronger colours. The mounts are of brass or copper, though other metals could be used where the general colour warranted their adoption.

When the Apartment to be furnished is of an unusual form, it is advisable to send a sketch with dimensions, showing the positions of doors and windows, and

the height of the ceiling. It is a great advantage to have furniture designed specially to suit a given space, though the man who built a house to fit some carpets he had inherited, probably carried this principle too far. Full advantage can be taken of recesses, any peculiarity of form suggests possibilities not to be thought of in connection with furnishing a room of the regular shape. There is no extra charge for designs made and submitted for special purposes, even though the Client does not have them executed. In the case of "no repeat" designs, an extra 10 per cent. is added, and an agreement made that the design is not to be used again.


The Prices quoted are for Best Materials and Workmanship only—no lower quality of materials being used, or slipshod workmanship being permitted.

The Furniture is Carefully Packed and forwarded Carriage Paid to any Railway Station in Great Britain.


